

Moscow on the Cahaba – The Balloon Rises Chapter II Part II

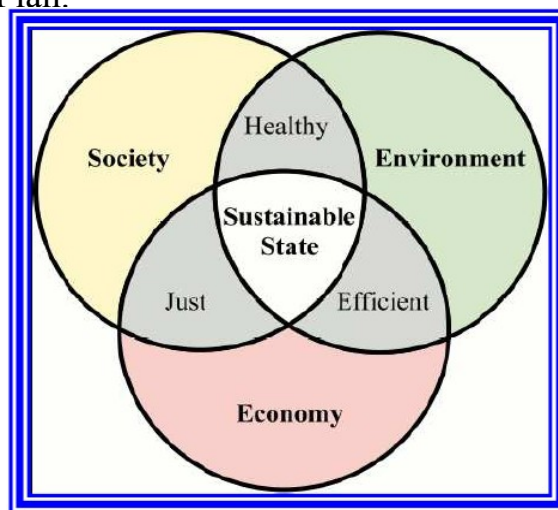
