

Moscow on the Cahaba Chapter II Part III “The Council”



Darling Natasha/Poopice, in my last series of communications, Boris told you how a self employed socialist had appropriated His Personal Data Assistant (PDA). “The PS.NET Citation Writer is currently undergoing final development and beta testing. It is designed to run on the standard PS.NET Mobile Data Workstation or stand alone on Microsoft Pocket PC hand held units. The initial release and certifications will be for the Florida market with other states to follow. Full release is scheduled for Q407. The programs interface with the PS.NET Message Switch to allow integrated instant inquiry to local, State, and NCIC database. The programs also support integrated cameras for evidence/security and card readers for operator input. The complete system is supplied with network based inquiry and review/approval programs and a wide variety of standard reports. It also includes standardized interfaces and API’s to allow integration with court and other external systems.
