the authority to "approve the
acquisition, lease or
sale of trust property,"

"income generated from acquired
property shall accrue to the
state's general funding;"

PROPOSED STATEWIDE AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE (1)

To propose an amendment to the
Constitution of Alabama of 1901,
providing that the Alabama Forever
Wild Land Trust be established for the
acquisition, maintenance and protec-
tion of lands and water areas in this
state having unique ecological sys-
tems, plant and animal life, geological
formations, wild habitats, recreational
value and scenic beauty; said amend-
ment providing for management of
such program and designation cate-
gories of lands and waters to be
acquired, providing for a board of
trustees to govern the Alabama Fore-
ever Wild Land Trust and a final
approval committee to approve the
acquisition, lease or sale of trust
property, providing tax deductions for
property donated to said trust, provid-
ing for funding of said land trust from
percentages of income earned from
investment of funds in the Alabama
Trust Fund and that income generated
from acquired property shall accrue to
the state's general funding; providing
for a stewardship program for the
maintenance of properties acquired by
said land trust, providing for conserva-
tion restrictions and easements and
the dedication of natural area pre-
serves, providing for an Alabama
Natural Heritage Program providing
that, after the state's 2011-12 fiscal
year, revenues directed to said land
trust shall be paid to the Alabama Trust
Fund, with the exception of 2.5% of
such revenues needed to continue
funding of the stewardship account or
as provided by the Legislature, and
providing that said amendment shall
be self-executing and that the invalid-
ity of any provision shall not affect the
validity of any other provisions thereof.
