ENROLLED, An Act,

To repeal Constitutional Amendment No. 496 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to Crenshaw County, which provides for the judge of probate to receive the same salary as the district judge in the county; and to provide that this amendment shall be effective beginning the next term of office of the judge of probate.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Constitutional Amendment No. 496 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is repealed, effective beginning the next term of office of the Judge of Probate of Crenshaw County.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

1 following description of the substance or subject matter of
2 the proposed constitutional amendment:

3 "Relating to Crenshaw County, proposing an amendment
4 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to repeal, effective
5 beginning the next term of office of the Judge of Probate of
6 Crenshaw County, Constitutional Amendment No. 496, which
7 provides for the judge of probate to receive the same salary
8 as the district judge in the county.
